PIMA NEIGHBORHOOD ENCAMPMENT – SEPTEMBER 9-11, 2011

- Who:** All troops, 3rd grade and up. First and second grade Brownie leaders are invited to attend with their daughters. First and second grade Brownie troops are invited to attend for the day on Saturday.
- What:** Camping and fun in the pines! Our neighborhood encampment!
- Where:** Willow Springs Program Center, west of Prescott, Arizona
- When:** September 9-11, 2011
- Cost:** \$34 per person. \$14 for troops attending Saturday only (no meals are included for any day-only people). Registration is due June 15. Space is limited--first come, first served!

Get ready! We are having our fall Neighborhood Encampment this year at Willow Springs, our awesome Girl Scout camp located outside of Prescott, about 1.5-2 hours from Scottsdale. It's a huge and gorgeous camp, the Cadillac of our council's camps. You'll love it!

Wide Games! We will plan a wide game on Saturday to reflect the theme. The remainder of the time is open for your own troop's activities, so you can take a hike, work on a badge, or even give your girls some down time. Whatever you wish! We will need adult and older girl volunteers to help plan and run the Wide Game. Please email Lee (lee@reality.com).

Older Girl Program: Archery is available for 4th graders and up (approx 1 hr/group, \$4/girl). The Challenge Course is available for girls 6th grade and up or at least 10 years old; prices are: low course--half-day (\$6) or full-day (\$10), full-day high course (\$14), or night zip line (\$22).

Meals! Saturday breakfast, Saturday dinner, and Sunday breakfast will be provided. Each troop will provide their own lunch on Saturday, dinner on Friday, and any snacks they wish. Feel free to buddy up with another troop! (This is a great bridging or friendship building opportunity!)

Accommodations! There are various cabins and buildings for us to stay in, each of which accommodate a different number of people. Younger girls and first-time campers are generally most comfortable in the dorms, while older girls will stay in cabin sites or even platform tent sites. Some buildings have beds, some have only mattresses. The price for accommodations is included.

Swaps! Once again, we will have a swap exchange. Please prepare your swaps around a wilderness/camping/outdoors theme or the encampment theme. We suggest that each girl bring at least ten swaps, but that's up to you and your troop.

Patches! Please note the form for the Patch Design Contest. Once again, we will select the best design created by our girls for our Encampment patch. Designs are due on September 16.

More information soon! The full registration packet will be distributed in August. In it, you will find detailed information including directions to the camp, the schedule, the menu, and so forth. Troop camping assignments will be available a week or two before the encampment.
